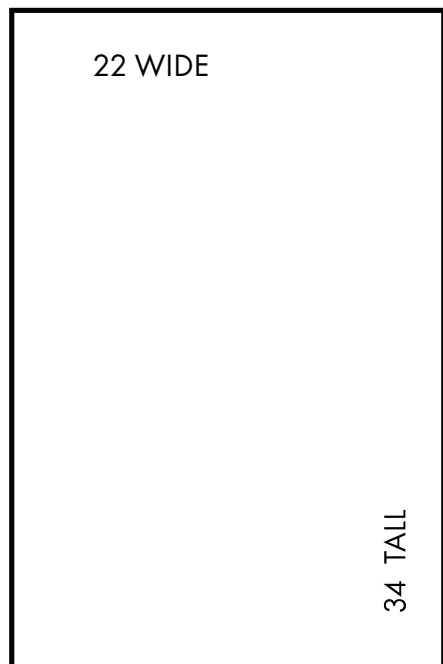


PRINTING COPY SHOP VERSIONS



The copy shop version of your pattern is designed to be printed on a wide format printer.

These printers are often found at copy and print shops, hence the name “copy shop version.”

You’ll be able to save time cutting and taping by using the copy shop version of the patterns.

HOW IT WORKS

Take your file to your local copy shop -- you can do this with a USB flash drive or you may be able to upload the file to your copy shop’s cloud service depending on available technology.

The file is a PDF and is the formatted size is ARCH D (or ANSI D).

Tell the counter person that you would like the file printed with no scaling or at “actual size.”

Verify that your pattern has been printed correctly by checking the test square before leaving -- it should measure 2” x 2”.
